## **ELIGIBILITY**

All applicants must have a minimum GPA of 2.80

### **Undergraduate or First Year Graduate Students:**

Must currently be enrolled in a civil, environmental, construction or related program at UCSD or SDSU. Open to individuals with academic standing of freshman through first year graduate student. Students completing their education in Spring/Summer 2021 are not eligible.

### **Community College Transfer Students:**

Must be transferring to a four-year university, located in San Diego County, and enrolling in a civil, environmental, construction or related program for the 2020-2021 academic year.

## **PROMPTS:**

Please respond to all four prompts and submit responses in one PDF document. Responses are limited to approximately 350 words each.

1. What motivates you to pursue a career in Civil, Environmental, or Construction Engineering?
2. What are your professional goals?
3. Summarize your involvement in student and volunteer activities (such as ASCE), and discuss any leadership positions you held.
4. Summarize your work/internship/research experience.
